

Note

- Remove the plastic packaging from the filter before use.
- Keep plastic packaging away from children as it may cause suffocation.

How to Prepare/Change the Filter

Hold the top cover of the product with both hands and pull up. Remove any tape used to secure unit during transit.



2 Grasp the filter cover hole on the rear and pull cover out and then up to remove and access filter.



Remove the filter from the product and then remove the plastic packaging from the filter.

Failing to remove the packaging will result in abnormal sounds and the filter will not work properly; and it may cause a fire or other damage to the product.

Slide the filter back into the unit with tabs on filter facing outward.





Replace filter cover.

Plastic / packaging


- Insert the cover into the fixed groove at the bottom of the product.
- ► Slide the cover forward so that the cover fits into the top grooves.





Cover-positioning groove at top

Hold the top cover of the product with both hands and slide it back in place, making sure the logo appears in the front.




Place purifier in desired location and plug into wall outlet.

For filter replacement:


When the filter installation is complete, press the Sleep + "Auto" button on the control panel for five seconds or more to reset the filter indicator light.

► The red filter light will turn off when the product is reset.

Control Panel Descriptions

Sleep ①	Sleep mode / Timer	^	Increase the timer and fan speed setting value
LED 🛜	LED ON/OFF & Wi-Fi® connection (LED off cycle lasts 6 hours)	Auto	Smart Auto mode
\	Decrease the timer and fan speed setting value	(h)	Power ON/OFF

Normal Operation

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When the air purifier turns on, the sensor is initialized and the display shows \[\begin{array}{c} - \begin

Press the \bigcirc button to turn on.

► The previously selected operation mode will be displayed.

Press the \checkmark \land button on the control panel to select your desired fan speed.

➤ You can adjust the fan speed from level 1 (F1) to level 18 (F18).

Note: The default home display on Wi-Fi® models will show a PM2.5 reading. Once the \checkmark \land button is pushed, the display will switch to show designated fan speed.

How to Install Casters (Optional)

1 Inside of the air purifier package, there is a small box containing four casters and eight screws.

2 Remove the four bottom bases from the air purifier with a screw driver.

3 Replace each base with a caster, utilizing two screws per caster.

4 Retain the removed bottom bases and screws for future use.
