Subject: Menu and Read File Released: October 22, 2025

In alignment with TL003 – 2025 (New Menu0118 and Read0517 file) it is important to use latest menu file (menu0118+) and read file (READ0517+) or greater.

These files are loaded within the zip file of each ML3 software release (51XX - ThinLINE®, 53XX - PrimeLINE® & EliteLINE®, 57xx - NaturaLINE®), pictured below. It is recommended that the **complete zip folder** is downloaded and all of the subfiles be extracted onto the USB. The menu and read files are periodically updated. They are included within the **software zip files**. Below is a picture of the current software as of this TechLINE's release.

When loading software onto the unit, the latest configuration at time of release will also be loaded. If at a later time a newer configuration is released, it should be loaded after uploading software. For example: if software scrl539X came with configuration cf250131 (YYMMDD) and later configuration cf250315 was released; load 539X first and then 250315. If 250315 is loaded first and then 539X is loaded, then the system will boot up with the previous configuration (250131) and not implement any changes made in the latest configuration.

Once the software is uploaded, do not revert to a previous version as this can result in data errors.

## To summarize, the below points should be followed:

- Use only Carrier authorized tools such as the MST (07-00572-00)
- Use the latest version of ContainerLINK (available on your device's app store)
- Use the most up to date Menu and Read files (currently Menu0118, Read0517)
- After loading software, ensure unit setpoint and configuration remains unchanged.

Alternate non-Carrier interrogation or software uploading tools can result in data errors, similar to what was noted in TL003-2025 when using an older version of the 2 files.
